NOTICE TO ACFS CUSTOMERS

RE: DP WORLD INFRASTRUCTURE SURCHARGE RATE INCREASE PORT OF BRISBANE

Dear Customer,

DP World Stevedores Operations have recently advised of an increase to their Infrastructure Surcharge effective from **2nd January 2012**. This rate increase applies to both Import and Export Containers.

Regrettably, ACFS will need to pass on this increase as a direct consequence of this increase of the Terminal Infrastructure Surcharge.

As a result, ACFS will include a charge to your account of \$32.50 from our Port of Brisbane Operations effective from **Tuesday 2nd January 2012**, and will be effective for all containers that are to / from DP World & Patrick terminals.

Patrick Terminal increased the Infrastructure surcharge in July of 2011, and ACFS have absorbed the increase to date.

Despite the payment terms of 7 days being imposed on ACFS by the Terminal Operators, in the circumstances we are pleased to confirm that ACFS will maintain the additional charge in accordance with your usual terms of payment.

ACFS would also like to extend our apologies for this short notice, as we only received notification of the significant increase from DP World on Friday 23rd December 2011 at 1pm.
